Get ready for an authentic Thai massage at [Wat Pho](#). It is primarily known for its reclining Buddha statue. You can get massage for 420 Baht per hour.

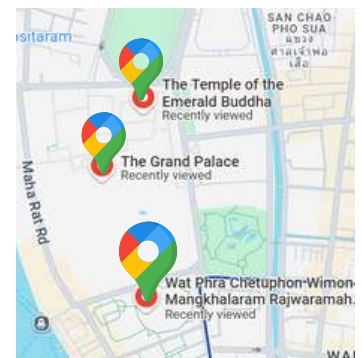
