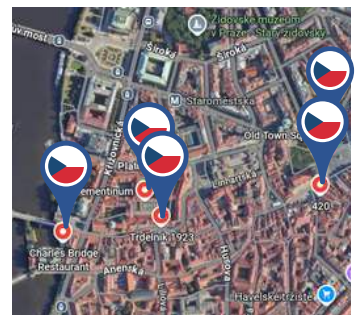

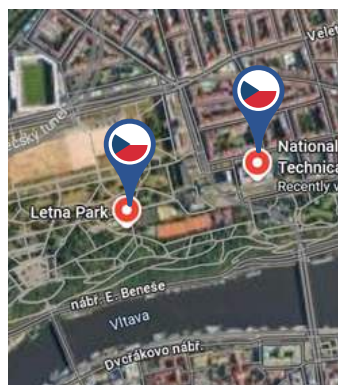
Midday

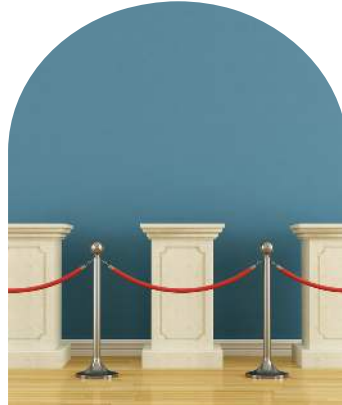

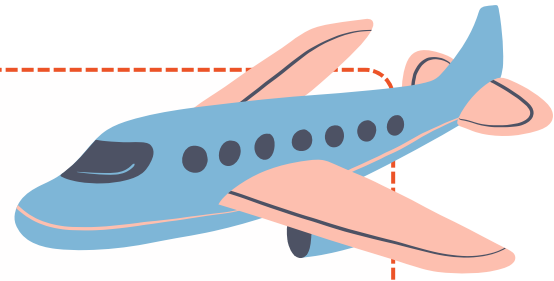

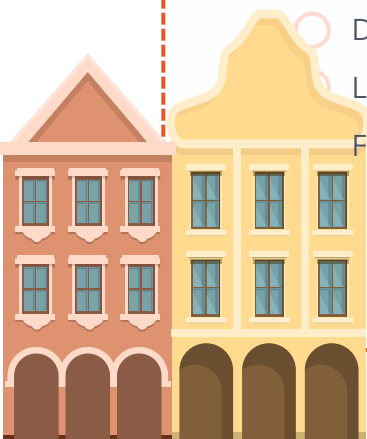
