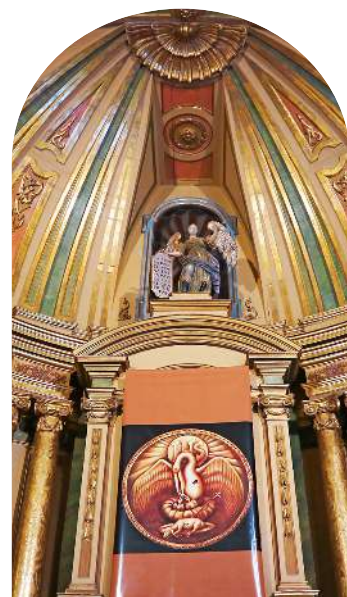

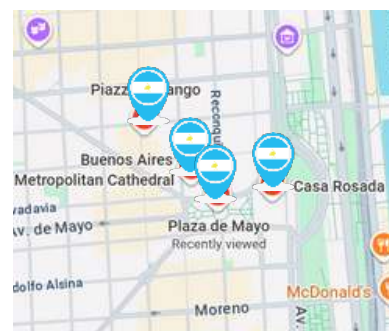

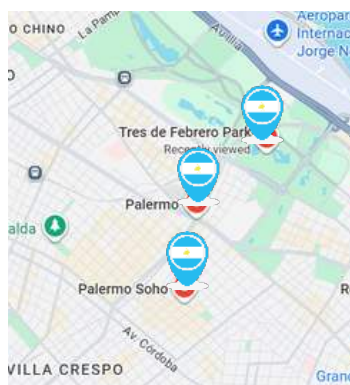

DAY TRIP OR FURTHER EXPLORATION

Option 1

On your last day in Buenos Aires, you have two options. Your first option is to take a day trip to **Tigre**, an Argentine town on the Paraná Delta. This touristy destination is only an hour-long journey from the city center and is among the top full-day expedition options. It is only 28 km north of Buenos Aires City.

Highly Recommended

Book half-day or full-day Tigre Delta Tours. These guided experiences include boat tours and visits to Tigre's must-see sites, such as **Tigre Art Museum** and **Puerto de Frutos**.

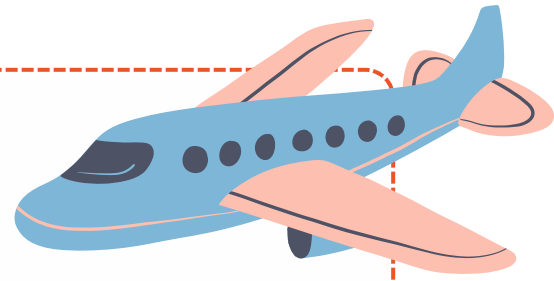
