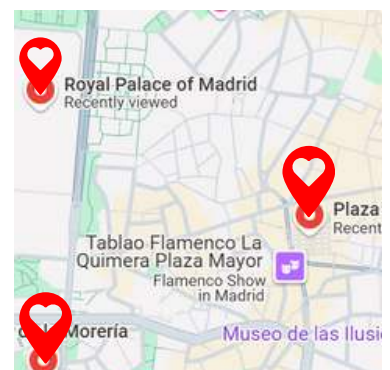

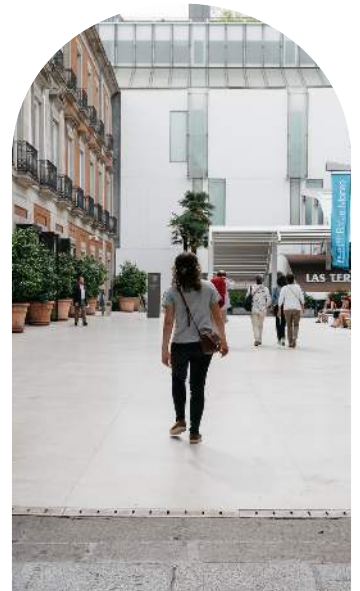

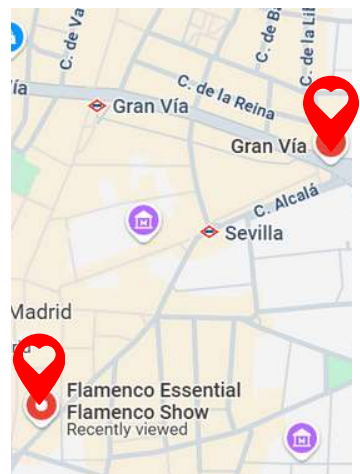
Afternoon
