Conclude your day with a romantic **Bateaux Mouches** cruise along **the Seine**. Witness Paris's landmarks illuminated at night, including the Louvre.

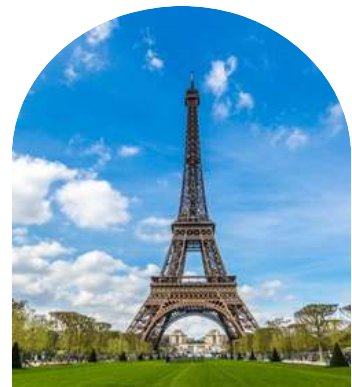

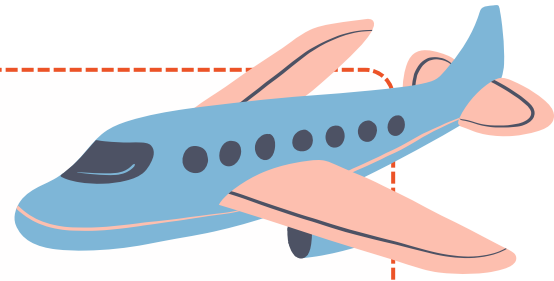

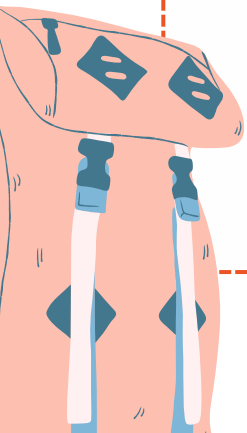
